If you attend Lubbock Cooper, Roosevelt, or Cotton Center High Schools, you must see your counselor for application, and return it to your counselor. If you attend one of these schools and mail your application to SPTC directly, it will not be considered.

- 1. High School graduating senior with a minimum grade point average of 2.5.
- 2. Must be a dependent of a current member and receiving telephone service from South Plains Telephone Cooperative Inc.
- 3. Student may attend any accredited college, university, technical school or hospital affiliated school.
- 4. A recipient is limited to one scholarship from South Plains Telephone Cooperative.
- 5. Any misrepresentation on application will disqualify the applicant.
- 6. Please submit a professional photograph with application (preferably a senior picture, no selfies and no proofs).
- 7. Scholarship checks will be made jointly to the recipient and educational institution. **Scholarship** checks may be spent only for tuition, fees or books.
- 8. Applicant to write a short essay stating why he or she is gualified for a scholarship.
- 9. Applicant to provide a copy of their high school transcript of grades.
- 10. Applicant to provide a letter of recommendation from their High School Principal, Counselor or a teacher.
- 11. Financial need will be given consideration.
- 12. **A personal interview may be required**. Applications will be reviewed individually. All **eligible** applicants will be notified by mail regarding their acceptance or rejection status.
- 13. The amount of the scholarship(s) awarded will be determined by available funds. The amount to be awarded will be decided by the Board of Directors of South Plains Telephone Cooperative, Inc.
- 14. Scholarship funds will be available for the Fall semester. If funds are not used within one year of notification, the scholarship award will be withdrawn.
- 15. South Plains Telephone Cooperative Inc. reserves the right to terminate the program or to change the provisions and conditions at anytime.
